The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns). When you are using a textbook as a source in your References list, you cite it the same way you would cite any other book. Type the first author's name. You type

For every in-text citation in your paper, there must be a corresponding entry in your reference list.
