The phosphate content of phosphorite varies greatly, from 4% to 20% phosphorus pentoxide. Marketed phosphate rock is enriched to at least 28%, often more than 30% P₂O₅. This occurs through washing, screening, de-liming, magnetic separation or flotation. By comparison, the average phosphorus content of sedimentary rocks is less than 0.2%. The phosphate is present as
